



## Installation

It is recommended the Snow Trax be installed with a #10 x 1 1/2" fastener with washer onto a thru-fastened panel system. Care and caution should be taken to ensure that the snow guard is properly tightened and sealed. Screws should be facing the eave of the roof and the guards should be installed starting on the first purlin every 18" with a row behind staggered 9" between the first row. Measure half-way up the roof and continue this pattern again. (See diagram)
